No frame exchange. Nucs are in returnable wooden 5 frame 9 5/8" boxes. We start them in early April then they are left to build for a few weeks, during which time the queen is evaluated. They will have 3+ frames brood and either 2 frames mixed honey/pollen, or 1 frame honey/pollen and a division feeder, your preference.

Choice of Italian, Carniolan Hybrid, or Italian Hygienic 2011 queen.

There is a \$10.00 refundable box deposit due at pickup.

*** Single Deep Colonies - late April/early May ***

 $9\,$ frames in our new equipment. We start these colonies in early April with $5\,$ drawn $9\,$ 5/8" frames of bees, honey and pollen, a new queen and $4\,$ new wood frames with beeswax foundation. They include a bottom board with reducer, a single deep box, an inner cover and an outer telescope cover. Choice of Italian, Carniolan Hybrid, or Italian Hygienic 2011 queen.

They are allowed to build and the queen is evaluated until the end of April, beginning of May.
